

BC Provincial ED LPN Practice (ECLIP) Program – FAQ

1. Where is the curriculum stored and accessed?

The online curriculum modules are hosted on **LearningHub**, with access links available through the **Emergency Care BC website**.

2. Who gets access and how?

- **LPNs:** May self-register for the online curriculum via [LearningHub](#).
- **Educators & Leaders:** Access to **lesson plans and supporting curriculum** will be provided once the classroom curriculum package is released with **Full Launch**.

3. How many hours is the program?

- The ECLIP online curriculum is approximately **75 hours** in total. Classroom days recommended with the program include an additional 4 to 5 days of learning.

6. Customized Competency Framework?

Within the [BC Provincial ED LPN Competencies](#), Health Authorities may customize the **“Local HA/ED Restrictions, Resources & Learning”** column to reflect organization-specific resources and employer-imposed limits on LPN practice.

- Customization, if required, should be completed by **designated HA leads** (e.g., Professional Practice, Clinical Leadership, or Educator Leads, depending on the HA). ECBC can collaborate with these designated leads to support the process and answer questions.
